

#### **DID YOU KNOW?**

'Tip-up' mounds caused by uprooted trees provide hiding places for ground-nesting birds and collect pools of rainwater necessary to salamanders and frogs. The logs will be decomposed by fungi, eventually becoming 'nurse logs' for new seedlings.
